

Internal and External Quality Assurance

At the end of the course, once your tutor/assessor has indicated that all learning outcomes have been achieved, your work may be submitted for Internal Quality Assurance (IQA).

The Internal Quality Assurer (IQA) will confirm that your tutor/assessor is consistently and fairly marking work to the required standard. An External Quality Assurer (EQA), employed by the awarding organisation, will also check your work to ensure that it has been assessed in-line with their agreed standards.

If at anytime during the above checks your work is referred, you may be required to re-visit and re-do some of the assessment criteria to ensure it is fully met.
